

## **GARCES MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL HEAD FOOTBALL COACH**

### **ATHLETIC PHILOSOPHY:**

### **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The Head Coach will abide by and reinforce in a supervisory capacity to the football coaches and players, the rules and guidelines set forth in the Garces Coaches Handbook, “Garces Rams – Pursuing Victory with Honor.” In addition, the Head Coach is expected to:

- Provide leadership and instruction toward the athletic development of each student-athlete in the Garces Memorial High School football program.
- Stress the importance of classroom performance and monitor athlete’s academic status.
- Oversee the activities of the football staff in planning, organizing and coaching of the Garces Varsity, J.V. and Freshman football teams.
- Ensure compliance with the Diocese of Fresno policies; as well as, the CIF rules, guidelines, and regulations.
- Direct the football staff in the preparation of analysis of opponent teams; analyze game statistics and tactical data of opponents and prepare game plans accordingly.
- Counsel team members in academic or disciplinary matters; consult with Garces Memorial administration and faculty for resolution of problems as required.
- Work closely with the Athletic Director to determine fiscal requirements and prepare budgetary recommendations; monitor, verify and reconcile expenditures of budgeted funds.
- Study, evaluate and implement innovations in football strategy and equipment.
- Represent Garces Memorial football programs in a professional manner at civic, charity or alumni events. This also applies to printed or televised media.
- Schedule and keep appointments. Set time for practices, games, travel, budgeting, meeting with Athletic Director and coaches.
- Develop and provide supervision for an off-season weight lifting and strengthening program. An additional stipend is available for this program.
- Organize and supervise a Summer Passing League program. An additional stipend is available for this program.
